Fund accounting and reporting taking too much time and effort?

Fund accounting and payroll should not take more than a few minutes a day, a few hours a week! Funds should stay safely separate except where you want them to interact. Treasurer's reports for management/supervisory meetings; tax reports for deposits and tax reporting; expenditure reports for cash flow tracking should all be immediate with no additional effort.

Fund Accounting – This comprehensive, yet simple to use, system has maintained the integrity of accounting for multiple funds since the 1980's. Commingling of funds by accident is virtually impossible. A full suite of reports allows management oversight.

Multiple Modules – In addition to the Fund Accounting General Ledger, the system includes Accounts Payable for bill paying and expense tracking, Payroll, Security and Accounts Receivable.

Accrual - In addition to the DCED's recommended modified accrual accounting, modified cash and cash basis accounting are also supported. Where tax tracking or utilities are included, full accrual accounting can be used.

Utilities and Taxes – Multiple utilities, such as garbage, sewage and electricity are available. Similarly for taxes such as flat taxes. Receivables from these can be separate or blended with late fee and credits supported.

Custom – No two municipalities are identical. As delivered, the software is flexible and can adapt to extensive variations. But beyond that, this entire system is owned and maintained by CSI. Additional functionality and options can be provided to address unique requirements. The current version of the software is the sixth generation and designed to take advantage of the latest advances in the computer industry.

Scalable - The system can be installed on a single workstation then later multiple workstations can be added. It can be configured as workstation(s) only or workstations with servers. There can be only one user or dozens with security controlling who accesses what.

No Recurring Fees – There are no recurring fees, monthly or annually. There are no additional fees for users or workstations. The license is perpetual. The only additional fees are if support is needed for training, installation, custom programming or similar services.
