In 1979, a small group of entrepreneurs in Pennsylvania who built and ran some of the world's first cable television companies were looking for a way to give back to the community. It was with this spirit that they created a non-profit organization called Pennsylvania Educational Communications Systems with the sole purpose of using the power of cable television for citizen education.

Today, that non-profit company goes by the name of PCN. The network is available on every cable system in the state and worldwide with PCN Select. PCN serves over 10 million Pennsylvanians.

As it has since the beginning, the non-profit network receives its funding from Pennsylvania cable television companies that carry the network on their channel lineup. PCN is not, in any way, state or federally funded.

PCN is here to celebrate, educate, and share news and events around our great state, expanding from being a window into the workings of the state government to adding PIAA high school championships.

Over the years, PCN has grown to highlight the history and culture of our Commonwealth, through events like the PA Farm Show, Groundhog Day, and Battle of Gettysburg historical programs, as we continue to provide unedited, full-length coverage of Pennsylvania politics and policy.
